### FINANCING UNIDO PROGRAMMES, INCLUDING NEW INITIATIVES FOR FUNDS MOBILIZATION

Report by the Director-General

Updates information provided in recent documentation on the level of the Industrial Development Fund, individual contributions to technical cooperation activities, progress in the implementation of integrated programmes, and developments with respect to UNIDO and the Global Environment Facility.

#### Introduction

1. The present document addresses the following mandates:

- Decision IDB.22/Dec.2 on financing the integrated technical cooperation programmes in developing countries, which requested the Director-General to report to the twenty-fourth session on the level of the Industrial Development Fund (IDF) and on individual contributions to technical cooperation activities. Supplements information provided in the Annual Report 2000 (IDB.24/2, chap. V.E and appendix B, and IDB.24/2/Add.1);
- Decision IDB.23/Dec.7 on integrated programmes, in which the Board called for a report on progress in the implementation of integrated programmes and on the overall situation of funds mobilization. Updates relevant information provided in various parts of the *Annual Report 2000* (IDB.24/2);
- Resolution GC.8/Res.2 on the Global Environment Facility (GEF). Highlights selected recent developments with respect to GEF in UNIDO's operational programme that are covered in greater detail in document IDB.23/12.

2. Reference should be made to *the Annual Report 2001* for detailed information on funds mobilized and the overall situation in respect of the Industrial Development Fund (IDB.24/2, chap. V.E and appendix B) and to the addendum containing a list of technical cooperation activities approved or under implementation in 2001 (IDB.24/2/Add.1).

#### I. INTEGRATED PROGRAMMES

3. Since its initial elaboration and inception, as described in detail in the *Annual Report 1998* (IDB.21/10, part one), the integrated programme approach has been monitored and adjusted in response to developments over time. As of 30 April 2001, 43 programmes had been developed with a total volume of some \$256 million (including support costs). Funds available for these programmes amounted to \$65.8 million. A detailed overview is shown in annex I to the present document. In addition, some \$4 million of earmarked donor funds are being programmed, and future payments under signed agreements amount to \$6 million. Total funds available to integrated programmes therefore amount to \$76 million. As has been the practice at recent sessions, updated information on the progress of the individual programmes will be distributed during the session.

For reasons of economy, this document has been printed in a limited number. Delegates are kindly requested to bring their copies of documents to meetings.

4. Annual funds mobilized for the integrated programmes increased from \$23.7 million in 1999 to \$32.4 million in 2000. The chart in annex II shows the composition of funds mobilized per year. It is anticipated that by the end of 2001 total funds available to the integrated programmes will approach \$100 million.

## II. GLOBAL ENVIRONMENT FACILITY

5. Documents issued to recent sessions of the Board reflected important developments and growing potential with respect to the Global Environment Facility (GEF) in UNIDO's operational programme (IDB.22/4, IDB.23/11). That information is updated in chapter I of document IDB.24/12 on environment-related activities. In addition to providing concrete examples of approved or pipeline projects for GEF funding, the documents illustrate the range and intensity of activities undertaken for the successful cultivation of an organizational strategy to address the mandates contained in General Conference resolution GC.8/Res.2 on GEF and technical cooperation activities. This comprehensive approach represents a special new initiative for funds mobilization in UNIDO. While details are provided in the earlier documents, the following list highlights selected examples from the most recent update (IDB.23/12):

### November/December 2000

- UNIDO representation at GEF Council meeting;
- Decision to authorize executing agencies with expanded opportunities to access GEF funds for full-scale projects (in addition to preparatory phases as hitherto);

- GEF mission to Vienna to review terms of cooperation agreement;
- Approval of second phase of project on energy conservation and greenhouse gas emissions reduction in Chinese township-village enterprises (\$7.4 million net budget).

### January-March 2001

- UNIDO becomes member of GEF Inter-Agency Task Force on POPs;
- UNIDO participation invited in drafting GEF Council document on POPs;
- GEF requests UNIDO to take lead in preparing GEF POPs by-products strategy;
- GEF to consider funding up to 12 UNIDO projects per year (subject to availability of UNIDO supplementary resources);
- Six UNIDO project concepts informally submitted;
- GEF mission to UNIDO to finalize draft financial procedures agreement;
- UNIDO participation in GEF-UNEP information-sharing and data exchange workshop;
- Second phase of development and promotion project for strategy for GEF-fundable activities;
- Submission of project proposal for development of national strategy and implementation plan for POPs in China.

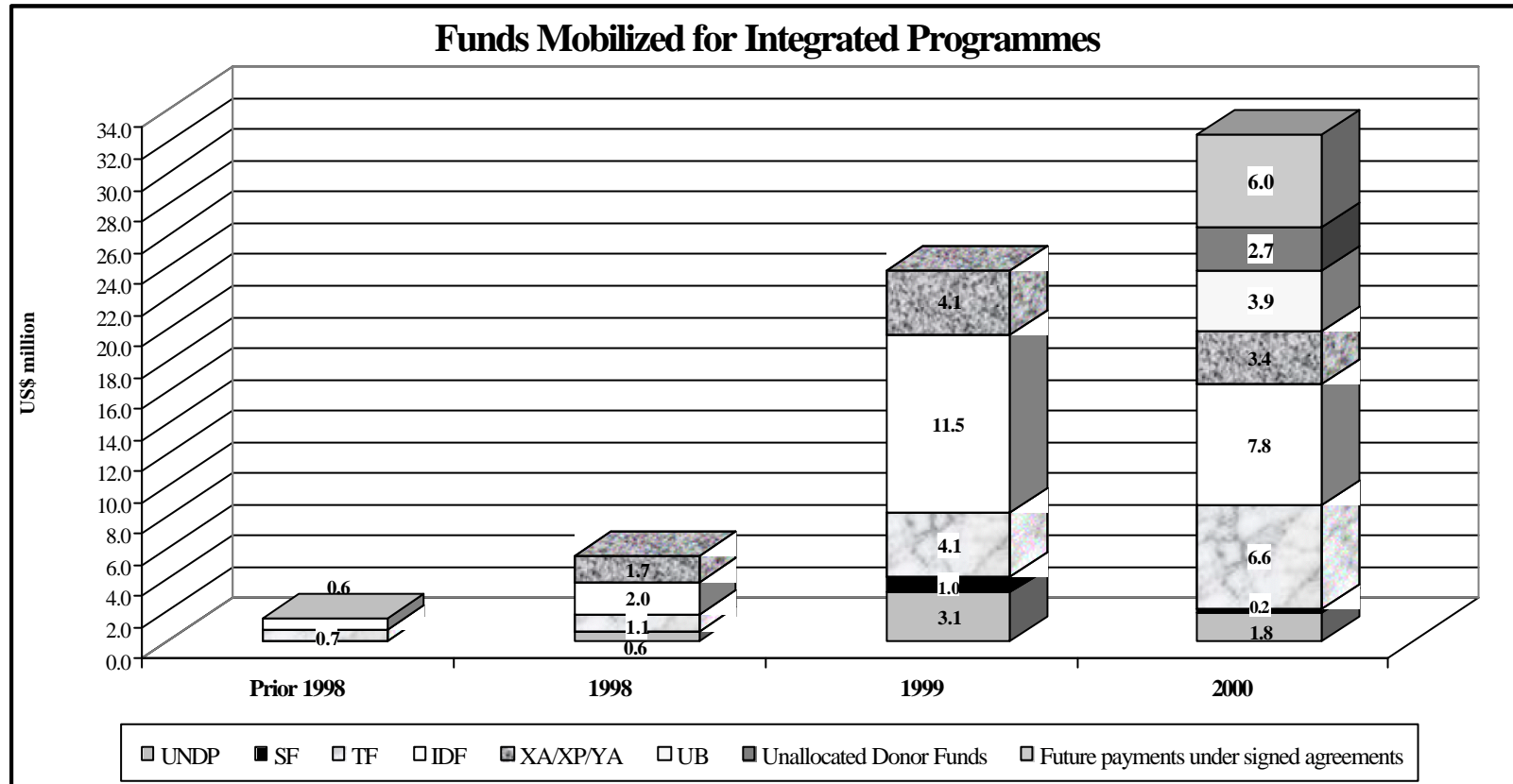
