FINANCIAL SITUATION OF UNIDO

Report by the Director-General

Summary

Provides information on the financial situation as at 30 June 1998 on the regular and operational budgets. In compliance with decision IDB.19/Dec.5, contains information on the progress achieved in the settlement of arrears and in the timely payment of assessed contributions.

1. The financial situation as at 30 June 1998 can be summarized in the following major points:

(a) The level of regular budget cash resources (\$17.7 million, including the Working Capital Fund) compares favourably with 1997 (\$11.3 million as at 30 June 1997);

(b) The rate of collection of current year assessed contributions of 61.8 per cent compares favourably with the same period for 1997 and 1996 (47.4 and 47.8 per cent, respectively);

(c) However, the collection rate of prior years' contributions (4 per cent) is less than in 1997 and 1996 (7.8 and 9 per cent, respectively);

(d) The Secretariat has communicated with Member States on payment plans for the settlement of outstanding assessed contributions;

(e) The cost of the staff separation programme is estimated at \$10.4 million with disbursements to date of \$9.1 million.

(f) Technical cooperation delivery, operational budget income and expenditures are at lower-than-budgeted levels.

2. The status of assessed contributions to the regular budget is shown in the annex to the present document. Outstanding contributions comprise:

3. As indicated in the annex, the voting rights of 62 Member States have been suspended owing to arrears in payment of assessed contributions, including five members of the Board and four members of the Programme and Budget Committee.

4. In its decision IDB.19/Dec.5, the Board reaffirmed the principle of collective financial responsibility of all Member States and their obligation to pay their assessed contributions in full and on time. In that decision, the Board adopted the report of the open-ended discussion group on timely payment of assessed contributions and requested the Director-General to take forward the measures recommended therein.

5. On 8 June 1998, UNIDO communicated the group's recommendations and Board decision IDB.19/Dec.5 in a letter to Member States whose voting rights had been suspended. The combined arrears of those Member States total \$30.06 million. Responses are now awaited to the Secretariat communication, which included a request to ascertain the interest of each Member State in settling its arrears under a payment plan, as decided by the Board.

6. Cash balances amount to \$17.7 million. A comparison of the cash flow estimate as presented to Member States in January 1998 and the present status is shown in table 1. The financial status of the staff separation programme is shown in table 2. Table 3 indicates the status of the operational budget.

ACTION REQUIRED OF THE COMMITTEE

7. The Committee may wish to take note of the information contained in the present document.

2. The voting rights of 62 Member States have been suspended.
3. In accordance with General Conference resolution GC/S.1/Res.1, the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro) cannot continue automatically the membership of the former Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia in UNIDO. Board decision IDB.19/Dec.5 on payment plans was not communicated to this country.
