# The **Challenge**

ver the last 30 years, we have worked to phase-out ozone depleting substances (ODS) under the Montreal Protocol, contributing to ozone layer protection and climate change mitigation. The Kigali Amendment (KA) adds hydrofluorocarbons (HFCs) to the list of substances which are to be phased-down. Its ratification, implementation, and enforcement pose challenges but also great opportunities.

If fully supported by governments, the private sector, and society, KA will reduce the projected production and consumption of powerful greenhouse gases HFCs by more than 80 percent over the next 30 years. KA is expected to avoid up to 0.5°C of global warming by the end of this century while continuing to protect the ozone layer.


