Readiness and Preparatory Support Programme

CONTEXT

The Readiness and Preparatory Support Programme (RPSP) supports developing countries in strengthening their institutional capacities, governance mechanisms, and planning and programming frameworks towards a stronger partnership with the GCF and a transformational, longterm climate action agenda.

All developing country Parties to the UNFCCC can access the RPSP, with at least 50% of the resources going to particularly vulnerable countries, including Least Developed Countries (LDCs), Small Island Developing States (SIDS) and African States.

UNIDO CONTRIBUTION AND STRATEGY

By virtue of its unique mandate and by leveraging a global network of partners on inclusive and sustainable industrial development, UNIDO engages with Countries globally to remove obstacles towards their climate action plans. These include, among others:

Technology assessment:

analyzing the maturity and markets of technologies supporting net-zero, climate resilient development.

Energy efficiency: creating policies and building capacity to implement energy efficiency standards across industry leaders.

Country programming:

identifying priority areas, fostering sustainable decision making and enabling a climatereceptive environment.

Green Hydrogen: enhancing the capacity to develop value chains, knowledge products and practical expertise on green hydrogen.

IMPACT

UNIDO has contributed to 17 Readiness grants in 15 countries, with 6 additional grants in 12 further countries in the pipeline.
