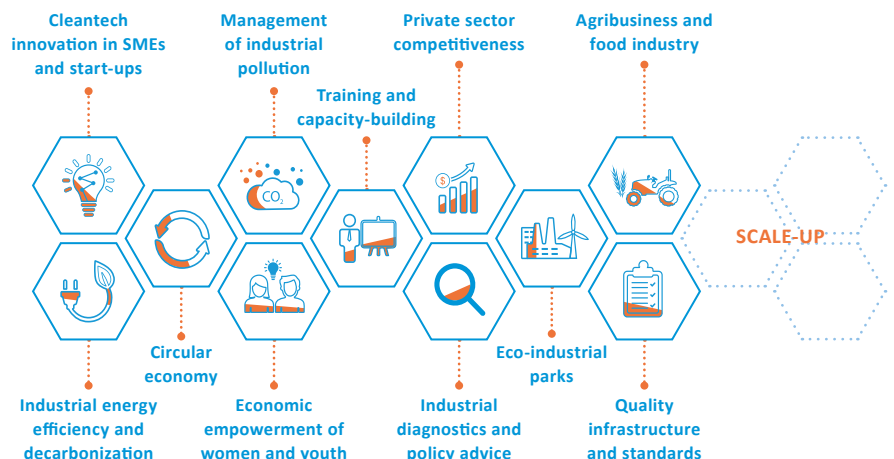
UNIDO envisions a **resilient, green and sustainable industry in Ukraine** and promotes a **strategic and integrated approach**.

EXAMPLES OF OUR INITIATIVES

3D-PRINTED PROSTHETICS AND JOB CREATION PROJECT

Funded by Japan

UNIDO is currently working to introduce technology for 3D-printed prosthetics in Western Ukraine and provide training to amputees and internally displaced people, helping them reintegrate into the job market. The project aims to support 100 people in getting access to quality prosthetics and employment opportunities.

GLOBAL QUALITY AND STANDARDS PROGRAMME (GQSP)

Funded by SECO

UNIDO enabled wooden window producers to measure the thermal performance of their products, optimize design and be more energy efficient. Standardization, accreditation and testing services have been strengthened for the conducive business environment, ultimately promoting exports.

EUROPEAN UNION FOR ENVIRONMENT ACTION

Funded by the European Union

UNIDO offered support to 15 companies of different sizes, which were forced to relocate operations, including Suziria, a pet food manufacturer from the Kharkiv region. UNIDO facilitated the installation of an autonomous solar power plant to ensure an uninterrupted supply of clean energy for their production lines.
